Video Visits \$

You have access to video visits with your PCP or another Sutter clinician through MHO.

- Video visits with a PCP are available to members age 3 months and older. Check with your PCP on availability and hours.
- All members age 18 months and older have access to video visits daily with a Sutter clinician.

Sutter Walk-In Care \$

In select areas, you have access to Sutter Walk-In Care for your everyday healthcare needs. It's open to everyone age 18 months and older, daily. Hours may vary depending on the location.

Urgent Care \$\$-\$\$\$

You have access to in-network urgent care locations while in the Sutter Health Plus service area. When you are outside of the Sutter Health Plus service area, you have access to any urgent care location.

Emergency Care \$\$-\$\$\$

You can access emergency care when you need it from any facility, in or out of the Sutter Health Plus network, without a referral. In the case of an emergency, dial 9-1-1 (where available) or go to the nearest hospital.

Mental Health & Substance Use Disorder Services

If you need mental health or substance use disorder treatment services, you have coverage through U.S. Behavioral Health Plan, California. You can schedule office or virtual visits as needed without a referral.

You can call 9-8-8, the U.S. national suicide prevention and mental health crisis hotline, to get immediate assistance for anyone experiencing a behavioral health crisis.
