Health Screening Test	
Abdominal aorta ultrasound screening for aneurysms	Immunizations/vaccinations
Bone marrow testing	Lipid panel
Carotid doppler	Mammogram
Chest x-rays	Oral cancer screening
Colonoscopy	Pap smears/Thin prep pap test
FDA-approved vaccines including Covid-19 vaccination	Prostate-Specific Antigen test (PSA)
Dental exam	Routine health check-up exam
Doppler screening for peripheral vascular disease	Serum protein electrophoresis
Echocardiogram	Skin cancer biopsy
Electrocardiogram (EKG)	Skin cancer screening
Eye exam	Stress test on bicycle or treadmill
Flexible sigmoidoscopy	Thermography
Hemoccult stool specimen	Triglycerides blood test



1 The Wellness benefit is payable once per calendar year, per covered person, if the covered person receives a covered health screening test while not confined in a hospital.

2 The Screening/Wellness benefit and some screening tests are not available in all states.
